Agenda - 4: Course Outcomes and program outcomes

CO - PO must be in uniform structure. Honours and General must be separately submitted for each department. The IQAC Coordinator should send the desired format and the departments should submit accordingly.

All departmental libraries will have to be activated and strengthened.
