MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

However, each side will make its best efforts to make arrangement within available amenities, accommodation to the visiting faculty and students.

AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC INTERCHANGE

This Agreement is made in Katwa College between Katwa College and Purbasthali College, both affiliated to the University of Burdwan. Both parties desiring to promote and develop cooperation in research and education intend by this Agreement to establish a program of educational cooperation and student and faculty exchange.

The REPRESENTATIVES

Specific publicity, recruitment of students and other collaborative projects involving both institutions will be agreed between each institution's representatives. For Katwa College its representative shall be the Head of the Institution. For Purbasthali College its representatives shall be the Head of the Institution. Collaborative activities may be subject to additional terms and conditions agreed in writing between the parties' representatives.

II. STUDENT EXCHANGE PRINCIPLES IN RECIPROCITY

Exchangesshallbereciprocalandbalancedoverthedurationofthisagreement. Each institution may send upto two (2)full-year students or four(4) one-semester students per year, as the number shall be calculated in terms of" student semesters / terms"(e.g., one student for one academic year equals two student semesters / terms). However, this number may vary in any given year, provided a balance of exchanges is obtained over the term of the Agreement. The normal exchange period shall be one semester or one academic year. In the event of an anticipated imbalance, either party may suspend or reduce intake or outflow of students to maintain the balance. Exchange students will be accorded the rights and privileges of regular attendance at the host institution, excluding the rights to graduate and /or earn degrees at the host institution. Blelie

III. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

Students who wish to participate in the exchange shall submit applications to the Principal (or other designated official) of their home institution. Exchange students shall be nominated on the basis of criteria determined by the home institution. However, all students must have completed at least two semesters of study at the home institution before beginning the exchange period and have demonstrated superior academic achievement and meet a language proficiency requirement, defined as the capability for students to succeed academically at the host institution. The host institution reserves the right to review these students and to make the final decision concerning their admission. The applications, together with other required documents, will be sent to the host institution by its designated deadline. The head of the host institution retains the right to review these students and to make the final decision concerning their admission. Lack of availability of desired classes may result in denial of otherwise qualified applicants.

IV. FEES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Exchange students shall pay tuition fees to their home institution while tuition fees will be waived at the host institution. Neither institution shall charge exchange students for tuition or application fees. Exchange students may apply for available scholarships at the host institution. The host institution may collect certain mandatory fees from incoming students which are not required from outgoing students. All such fees will be specified in advance.

V. REGISTRATION AND RECORDS

All exchange students must register on a full-time basis. Records will be established for exchange students as if they were regular Semesters students of the host institution. An official transcript of course work and grades will be mailed to the head of the home institution on the completion of each semester of attendance.

Exchange students are responsible for securing their own housing accommodations, but the host institution may provide assistance and support in locating appropriate housing. Each institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating student at any time for academic or personal misconduct in violation of established regulations of the host institution. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the agreement for the arrangements regarding other participants. Exchange students are subject to the same rules and regulations as local students. Upon completion of the exchange period at the host institution, the participating students must return to their home institution. No extension of stay will be authorized unless otherwise specified by the home institution.

VII. FACULTY EXCHANGE

Both participating institutions agree to encourage the development of a mutually-beneficial visiting faculty program. Faculty members in this type of exchange may be invited to participate in lectures, workshops, symposia, research and special projects, as well as offer short courses. Visitation lengths, course curricula, and compensation will be determined on a case by case basis.
