Agenda 1: To read and confirm the previous meeting dated 22.2.2023

The resolution of the previous meetings held on 22.2.2023 is read and confirmed unanimously without any change.

#### Agenda - 2: NAAC related issues

The IQAC Coordinator says that the recommendation given by NAAC Peer Team in 2018 should be acted upon. The Principal says that internship in B. Ed has to be taken into account. IQAC Coordinator says that a proposal for Add on Course on Karate has been received. The four Add on Courses will be started from April. The Principal says he will be look into the matter of recommendations for the teachers taking Add on Courses.

He also says a policy document for Research encouragement has to be formulated.

### Agenda - 3: Creation Computer Lab (ICT based learning) for students

The IQAC Coordinator proposes a computer Room for use of students along with staff with atleast strength of 50 computers. The Principal says that the Library Reading Room will be partitioned to provide this facility.

### Agenda - 4: Reports regarding different Sub-committees function

The coordinator place the report

- i) The campus placement and internship opportunities be strengthened This work not at all satisfactory level, all members said the Placement Cell will take immediately action. Principal says he will be taken responsibility to meet up the situation.
- Use of ICT in Teaching, evaluation and administrative process could be improved upon – These works already maintained by ICT and have more options to improve this recommendation.

- iii) Along with more Certificate and Add on programs, pass percentage of students must be enhanced – We are trying to meet up this recommendation and we have got three proposals for open the Add on Course and Governing Body also has given the open these programs.
- iv) Research potential of the teachers could be exploited through development of a good policy document and implementation of the same – in this point college has fallen in week position.
- v) An integrated library management may be put in place College library maintained ILMS and need to more development.
- vi) MoU's with Institutes / CSIR Labs in Kolkata and nearby areas may be signed for student and Faculty exchange and collaborative research - We have signed two MoU's but after that no activities are not done still now.
- vii) A consultancy Cell could be established for offering consulting services to the industry / agriculture No work has been done still now.
- viii) All old buildings including Classrooms, Hostels, Quarters etc. should be renovated or reconstructed This recommendation is meet up and more works are continued.
- ix) Alumni Association activities could be made more vibrant with the active involvement of the members – This recommendation is not meet up at all, Coordinator said to Principal, it is necessary to take urgent steps as he is an alumni of this College.
- x) Faculty be motivated to get major and minor research projects from different government / non government and private funding agencies – At present as UGC has stop their funding in MRP so no work has been done.

Mr. Asit Kumar Mandal and Subhajit Sannyal proposed the College website is not up to the mark and it is immediately required to develop the website. All information must be shown in the College Website in proper indication. Dr. Bharat Chandra Dalui said the College Website is now modified and hopefully it will be completed within a month. Principal says all data filled up in the website in urgent basis and ICT, Convenor takes full responsibility.

#### Agenda - 5: Class Room modernization

The Coordinator proposes a big computer room for use of students along with staff with strength of 50 computers. The Principal says that the Library Reading Room will be partitioned to provide this facility.

Asit Mondal says that steel set chairs should be set up for the office. The Principal says 250 benches for students should be purchased along with 100 chairs. 8tables and proportionate number of chairs would be purchased for the canteen. Podiums are also required for some big classrooms.

### Agenda - 6: Academic and Administrative atmosphere

The Principal says that the IQAC Coordinator should see which classes are not taking place and why. The IQAC, Coordinator says that there should be a team to monitor. The Principal says that IQAC should coordinate with the departments and sort out the problems. The IQAC, Coordinator says that there should be an Academic Cell with IQAC, Coordinator, one TR member, Teachers' Council Secretary and two any IQAC members, to seat with the departments and to uplift the academic atmosphere. The Principal says that with retirement of all non – teaching staff holding substantial posts in the next few years, the administrative system will be completely jeopardized. The Head Clerk says that after his retirement in e early 2025, the accounts of the Cooperative Society and Provident Funds may be in a problem and thus a system of regular audits for these two may be instituted.

### Agenda - 7: Library modernization

The Librarian raised the urgent issue of library modernization and the need for more space in the Library. The Head Clerk proposed that the Morning and Day sections of the library may be merged so that the space of the Morning Library may be utilized. The IQAC, Coordinator said that the Reading Room may also be utilized for library extension.

The College will take initiatives for more outreach program activities fulfilling the criteria set down. Coordinator says that in this regard NSS and NCC may take more initiatives.

### Agenda - 2: Teacher and student feedback analysis report 2022-2023

Feedback analysis report of last two semesters (SEM - I, III, V & II, IV, VI of AY 2022-23) was presented before the committee. Both Teacher and Student Feedback analysis reflected overall satisfaction in most of the criteria; However, some issues were raised both by teachers and students, on which following resolutions were taken unanimously:

- i. A help desk for students to be set up immediately
- ii. Cleanliness in classrooms, Teachers' room, Library and Departments, corridors, toilets and drinking water arena to be maintained regularly. Installation of dustbins to be done immediately.
- iii. At least one Drinking water and toilet both male and female facilities to be installed in every floor

- v. At least eight classrooms to be enabled with projectors and Smart classroom setup for blended mode of education.
- vi. Procurement of Learning Management System (LMS) to be done.
- vii. Student Data access to be provided to faculty members.
- viii. Steps for beautification of the college such as painting of college and hostel building, renovation of floors in college building and hostel, gardening etc. to be commenced immediately.
