



The Head of the Institutions are requested to take necessary initiative regarding registration in the Portal and organising the Event on 21.06.2026 in their colleges/institutes and ensure participation of all staff of the college.

Compliance Report with geotagged photographs to be submitted to the concerned officer of the college/institution by mail positively within 23.06.2026.

PHASE..1 Pre-Event Registration & Portal Setup

Step 1:- Access the Official Portal: Educational institutions and departments must access the official Ministry of Ayush registration portal at yoga.ayush.gov.in/yoga-sangam.

Step 2:-Complete Organization Registration: Complete the five-stage institutional registration process on the portal by entering:

- a):Organisation details
- b);Contact details
- c);OTP verification
- d) Venue registration (which will automatically record the geo-location of the venue)
- e);Other details

(Note: There is no registration fee for institutions or communities).

Step 3: Secure Reference ID: Upon successful registration, retrieve and securely retain the Reference ID sent via the confirmation email. This will be required later to download e-certificates.

Step 4: Encourage Individual Mobilization: Advise all individual participants (officers, staff, teachers, and students) to register independently via their own mobile phones or computers to record their personal participation.

PHASE 2: Execution on the Day of the Event (21st June, 2026)

****Ensure Mandatory Attendance:** Ensure the attendance of all categories of personnel—including permanent, contractual, part-time, daily-wage/casual workers, outsourced personnel, and those engaged on an honorarium basis.

****Adhere to Timings:** Execute the mass yoga demonstrations strictly from 6:30 AM to 7:45 AM.

****Coordinate Venues:** Ensure personnel participate from their respective offices/institutions, or at centralized venues like Red Road & Milan Mela if specifically nominated by the department.

PHASE 3: Post-Event Documentation & Compliance

****Upload Photos and Feedback:** Immediately after the event, upload high-quality photographs and event feedback onto the Yoga Sangam portal.

****Download E-Certificates:** Use the previously saved email Reference ID on the portal to download the official participation e-certificates.
